What: The Jefferson School PTO meets regularly to fulfill their purpose:

- To promote an effective educational program at Jefferson School.
- To help promote understanding and communication between the parents/guardians and staff, and to enhance the program.
- To help provide volunteer assistance at the school.
- To help provide materials and programs that will benefit the students.

At this time, the Jefferson PTO is looking to fill several board positions including:

President or President-Couple

- Prepare agendas for and conduct Executive Board and general membership meetings
- o Determine meeting times of all PTO meetings with the approval of the principal
- Share membership ex-officio of all standing committees of the Parent Advisory, with the exception that the president shall not serve on the nominating committee

Vice President or Vice President-Couple

- Two year term. First year work closely with the president to learn procedures for every facet of the office.
- Conduct meetings if president is unable to do so.
- Second year of term is spent as the president of PTO.

Secretary

- Take minutes and keep records of each general PTO and Executive Board Meeting.
- Arrange for a qualified substitute when unable to attend a meeting.
- o Coordinate PTO articles for school newsletter.
- o Write thank you letters and other correspondence as necessary.
- Maintain historical records of the PTO activities and Jefferson School events (newspaper clippings, photos, etc.). May appoint a school historian for this duty.

• Stevens Point Area PTO Representative

- o Attend all Stevens Point Area PTO meetings and Jefferson PTO meetings.
- o Act as liaison between the two groups.
- TERM LIMITS: Officers will serve a one year term of office with options to serve a two
 year term if re-nominated and elected. The exception shall be the office of treasurer,
 which shall be a two year term.
