



Military Recruitment “Opt Out” Request Form

Section 9528 of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 requires schools to release student’s (17 years or older) private information to military recruiters unless families chose to “opt out” in writing.

The following form provides the option to remove your child’s and/or family’s name from the Military Recruitment list.

_____ As a parent/legal guardian, I am exercising the right to “opt-out” and request that you do not turn over the name, address and telephone number of the following student to the Armed Services, Military Recruiters or Military Schools.

_____ As a student the age of majority, I request my own name, address, telephone number not be released to the Armed Services, Military Recruiters or Military Schools.
