



A notice will appear on the opening page letting you know there are online forms available for you to complete.

You may click the link at the bottom of the message, or click Online Forms on the left.



## Several forms are available for online completion:

- 1. WIAA Athletic Eligibility Information is required for all student athletes in grades 9 12
- 2. Athletic Code of Conduct is required for all student athletes
- 3. Concussion Fact Sheet is required for all student athletes
- 4. WIAA Alternate Year Athletic Physical Card (Optional form to be completed based on the date of the student athlete's last physical. Please see the forms for appropriate dates.)

These forms are to be completed before your student is allowed to participate in school athletics. Your electronic (typewritten) signature on these forms is the legal equivalent of your manual signature. You will be asked agree to have your electronic signature accepted as your legal signature.

The Athletic Code of Conduct is included in its entirety. Please read and review this document with your student athlete before both of you sign and date the agreements on the last page.

Continue with each step (there are four forms for grades 9-12 and just three forms for grades 7-8).

The last form on the list for all grades is the Alternate Year Physical card. It is an optional form.


Use this information as a guideline to determine if your student qualifies to file an Alternate Year Physical Card:

- \* Prior to 4/1/2015: Physical Exam expired. A new exam is needed for athletic participation.
- \* Between 4/1/2015-3/30/16: Physical Exam is valid but an alternate year card, signed by parent or guardian is required.
- \* Exam dated 4/1/2016 to present: No new exam or alternate year card is needed at this time, but the Athletics Office needs of copy of the physical.

If you do not need to complete the Alternate Year Physical form, simply skip it.

If your student qualifies for the Alternate Year Physical form, please be sure to complete all fields.


Once you have completed all forms you will be asked to submit all forms.



If you did not complete the Alternate Year Physical form, you will still be able to submit all forms. Simply click Step 4 (or step 5 for grades 9 -12) on the right.



The Submit button will then be available. Notice that the list of forms indicates t the Alternate Year Physical form was skipped.



After clicking the submit button you will receive this message. Your athletic forms are complete and the message to complete these forms is no longer displayed on your family access home screen.
